This unique expression of Boal Madeira has been produced to celebrate our 300 year anniversary. Whilst the category of 40 Year Old Madeira exists in principle on the island, there were currently no examples available, and yet it is an age at which Madeira wines can express themselves with incredible depth and complexity.

Ricardo de Freitas, the third generation to direct the bespoke house of Barbeito, was well placed to create such an individual wine, surrounded as he is by ancient casks first assembled by his grandfather. Of all the noble varieties on the island, the Boal was selected to offer the ideal combination of venerable age, and yet still retain a freshness and vigour.

At the heart of this blend is a very old and unique cask of Boal, naturally aged for 85 years. Despite this magnificent history, the grapes can still be traced to their origin in the Campanario district, which lies on the south side of the island, and is well known as a fine traditional source of this noble grape variety.

This rare Madeira is best enjoyed at a cool room temperature, at the end of a meal, perhaps with nuts or sweetmeats.
